After obtaining a bachelor degree in Law in Brazil, his home country, Mauricio concluded an MA in Arts Management at the University of Barcelona in 2007. During that period in Europe, he also participated from the Erasmus programme for 6 months at London's City University as a visiting student, as well as joined the 2006 summer course on European cultural policies at Jyväskylä University, in Finland. His professional background started at PricewaterhouseCoopers as a tax advisor, prior to his experience in Arts Management, which includes works at the Catalan Institute for Cultural Industries, in London and the São Paulo State Symphony Orchestra Foundation.
